various maintenance projects that
will continue throughout the year.
The unusually wet spring has
provided some challenges for our
DPW. We will be doing some
street paving, sidewalk repairs, and
repair work on the parking lot at
the recreation park near the big
diamond and horseshoe pits.
On June 3rd & 4th new playground
equipment will be installed by

project is near \$30,000 with funds
raised throughout the community.
It will be located by the pavilion at

The village has purchased a new
