but leaves on the street.**
The last two brush pickups for
the year will be Thursday,
October 27th and Thursday,
November 17th. There will be
no brush pickup in December,
January or February. If you do
have brush from general yard
clean-up, you can take it to the
DPW Garage at 70 N. Main St.
