The minutes of the regular meeting of the Winsor Township Board held January 2, 2018 had been mailed to each board member. There being no additions or corrections the minutes were approved as presented.

A motion was made by David McCormick, supported by Robin Buschlen to approve the January 2018, bills and to authorize payment of the February 2018 bills of \$57,745.14. The motion carried.
