

**WINSOR TOWNSHIP  
BOARD MEETING  
JANUARY 3, 2023**

The regular meeting of the Winsor Township Board was called to order by Matt Reibling, Supervisor, at 5:00 pm, in the township boardroom.

Present: David Armbruster, David McCormick, Matt Reibling and John Walsh. Also present: Nick Pavlichek, Fire Chief, and Todd Talaski, Huron County Commissioner.

Absent: Nancy Heck

The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Todd Talaski reported that there was a new commissioner, Don Musser, for the Bad Axe area and that all union contracts have been signed.

The minutes of the last regular meeting, held December 6, 2022, had been distributed to each board member. There being no corrections and one addition, the minutes were ordered approved.

After review, a motion was made by David McCormick, supported by David Armbruster, to authorize payment of the January 2023 bills of \$11,724.24



David Armbruster and John Walsh reported on the meeting of the Fire Hall Expansion Committee held January 2, 2023. The architect and the committee discussed obtaining a survey and site plan for the property. Prior to a survey, the Supervisor will contact the Assessor and have the two lots combined into one. The Supervisor also stated that trustees assigned to committees, such as the Fire Hall Committee, shall be compensated for each committee meeting attended, as a regular meeting.


