

WINSOR TOWNSHIP
BOARD MEETING
MARCH 7, 2023

The regular meeting of the Winsor Township Board was called to order by Matt Reibling, Supervisor, at 5:00 pm, in the township boardroom.

Present: David Armbruster, Nancy Heck, David McCormick, Matt Reibling and John Walsh. Also present: Nick Pavlichek, Fire Chief and Andrew Johnson from Apple Blossom Wind Farms.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Andrew Johnson reported on the recent activities of Apple Blossom, noting that American Electric Power [Apple's parent company], has entered into an agreement to sell its unregulated, contracted renewables portfolio to IRG Acquisitions Holdings. The sale is expected to close in the second quarter of 2023.

A motion was made by David McCormick, supported by David Armbruster, to close the regular meeting and open the Budget Public Hearing. The motion carried.

John Walsh read the Notice of Budget Public Hearing for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2024.

The budgets for the General, Road, Cemetery and ARPA Funds for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2024 were discussed and reviewed.

After which, a motion was made by David McCormick, supported by Nancy Heck, to close the Budget Public Hearing and open the regular meeting. The motion carried.

A motion to approve the budgets for the General, Road, Cemetery and ARPA Funds, for the fiscal year ending March 31,2024, was made by David McCormick, supported by Nancy Heck. The motion carried.

The minutes of the last regular meeting, held February 8, 2023, had been distributed to each board member. There being only a minor adjustment, a motion was made by David McCormick, supported by David Armbruster, to accept the adjusted minutes. The motion carried.

After board members had reviewed and initialed the current months bills and auto-pays, a motion was made by David McCormick, supported by David Armbruster, to pay the current bills of \$15,622.26 and to approve the auto-pays. The motion carried.


A motion was made by John Walsh, supported by David McCormick, to increase the township's Grand Lawn Cemetery burial

Matt Reibling, and the board discussed several property tax issues and he noted that this year's Road Commission Meeting will be held on April 13, 2023.
