

WINSOR TOWNSHIP
BOARD MEETING
November 2, 2021

The regular meeting of the Winsor Township Board was called to order by Matt Reibling, Supervisor, at 5:00 pm, in the Township Boardroom.

Present: David Armbruster, Nancy Heck, David McCormick, Matt Reibling and John Walsh. Also present: Nick Pavlichek Fire Chief and Todd Talaski, Huron County Commissioner.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Todd Talaski gave an update on county activities including proposed ARPA projects, a new Asst. Prosecutor and noted that a windmill tax settlement is imminent with Detroit Edison.

The minutes of the last regular meeting, held on October 5, 2021 had been distributed to each member. After deletion, a motion was made by David Armbruster, supported by David McCormick, to approve the minutes. The motion carried.

A motion was made by David Armbruster, supported by David McCormick, to approve the payment of the October, 2021 bills of \$75,478.25, and to authorize payment of the November 2021 bills of \$ 111,432.82. The motion carried.

Nick Pavlichek, Fire Chief reported on department activities and possible ARPA Funds requests.

John Walsh reported that at the cemetery, Superior Tree had ground-up 12 stumps and removed the tree that had been struck by lightening.


Matt Reibling reported that the Berne St. project on replacing tubes and resurfacing may also include upgrading the street to a Class A Road next year.
