

**WINSOR TOWNSHIP
BOARD MEETING
OCTOBER 4, 2022**

The regular meeting of the Winsor Township Board was called to order by Matt Reibling, Supervisor, at 5:00 pm, in the township board room.

Present: David Armbruster, Nancy Heck, David McCormick, Matt Reibling and John Walsh. Also present: Todd Talski, Huron County Commissioner and Andrew Johnson, from Apple Blossom Wind Farms.

The pledge of allegiance was given.

Todd Talaski reported on county activities noting that a millage renewal for 911 Services will be on the November ballot. The county is having difficulty soliciting bids for ARPA projects as contractors cannot be guaranteed of product or materials, deliveries or availability.

Andrew Johnson reported that his company is concentrating on blade repair and other maintenance issues.

The minutes of the last regular meeting, held September 6, 2022 had been distributed to each board member. There being no additions or corrections, the minutes were ordered approved.

After review, a motion was made by David McCormick, supported by David Armbruster, to authorize payment of the October 2022 bills of \$6,137.21. The motion carried.


