

WINSOR TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING

February 5, 2019

The regular meeting of the Winsor Township Board was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by John P. Kohr, Supervisor.

Present: Robin Buschlen, John P. Kohr, David McCormick, and John Walsh.

Absent : Nancy Heck

The Pledge of allegiance was given.

The minutes of the regular meeting of the Winsor Township Board held January 18, 2018 had been mailed to each board member. There being no additions or corrections the minutes were approved as presented.

A motion was made by Robin Buschlen, supported by David McCormick to approve the January 2019 bills and to authorize payment of the February 2019 bills of \$9,862.50. The motion carried.

John Walsh reviewed journal entries and financial statements of the General Fund, as of January 31,2019. A motion was made by David McCormick, supported by Robin Buschlen, to approve the journal entries and financial statements .The motion carried

.A motion was made by Robin Buschlen, supported David McCormick, to approve the purchase of a used aerial truck from the Harbor Beach Fire Department. The motion carried.

A motion was made by John Walsh, supported by David McCormick, to amend the budget to include the fire truck at \$30,000 and new tires for \$5,000. The motion carried.

A motion was made by Robin Buschlen, supported by John Walsh, to approve Ordinance no. 2019- 1, "Prohibition of Marihuana Establishments". The motion carried.

A motion was made by John Walsh, supported by David McCormick, to send a letter to the Michigan Economic Development Commission stating that Winsor Township will support Active Feed Company, through its subsidiary, Farm Crest Foods, in their \$5,000,000 expansion, to add a new barn, which will hold 165,000 chickens, by approving a twelve year tax abatement. The motion carried.

John Walsh noted that a Budget Public Hearing will be held at the March 5, 2019 meeting, to set the budget for the March 31, 2020 year.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Robin Buschlen, supported by David McCormick, to adjourn. The motion carried.
