

WINSOR TOWNSHIP
BOARD MEETING
JANUARY 19,2021

The regular meeting of the Winsor Township Board was called to order, by Matt Reibling, Supervisor,[via Zoom Notice attached], at 4:00pm January 19,2021.

Present: David Armbruster, Nancy Heck, David McCormick, Matt Reibling, John Walsh, Nick Pavlichek, Fire Chief and Andrew Johnson, Apple Blossom Wind Farms.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given.

The minutes of the last meeting, held November 10, 2020 had been distributed to each board member. There being no additions or corrections, the minutes were ordered approved.

A motion was made by David McCormick, supported by David Armbruster to approve payment of the November and December bills and authorize payment of the January 2021 bills of \$ 26,968.64. The motion carried, D.A. Yes, N.H. yes, D.M. yes, J.W. yes, M.R. yes.

John Walsh noted that the 12/31/20 financial statements will be mailed to board members for approval at the March board meeting.

Matt Reibling said that the following Board of Review members would be recommended for new two year terms. Dale Collison, Denny Fritz and Dale Oeschger, with John P. Kohr and Garret Shetler as Alternates. A motion was made by John Walsh, supported by David Armbruster, to approve the appointments. The motion carried, D.A. yes, N.H. yes, D.M. yes M.R. yes, J.W. yes.

Andrew Johnson from Apple Blossom Wind Farms, discussed 2020 and 2021 projects. The 2021 projects will begin as soon as the road weight restrictions are lifted.

Nick Pavlichek, Fire Chief, discussed department operations for 2020. Noting that the department is receiving calls for “lift assists” for which they should be compensated. Repairs of non-operating fire hydrants were discussed.

Matt Reibling will check the status of the new stand by agreements with Chandler and McKinley Townships and report at the February meeting.

A motion was made by John Walsh, supported by David McCormick, to have 2021 payroll processing done by Christina Parmenter, for a \$1,200. fee, and to update the general ledger computer for \$350. to \$400. The motion carried, D.A. yes, N.H. yes D.M. yes, M.R. yes J.W. yes. [Later it was determined that the computer update wasn’t practical.]

Discussion of 2021 road repairs were tabled until the February meeting.

David Armbruster reported that the Village of Pigeon will have a Police Proposal at the next meeting.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Nancy Heck supported by David McCormick, to adjourn. The motion carried, D.A. yes, N.H. yes D.M. yes, M.R. yes, J.W. yes.
