

WINSOR TOWNSHIP
BOARD MEETING
NOVEMBER 10, 2020

The regular meeting of the Winsor Township Board, was called to order, at 4:00pm by John P. Kohr, Supervisor, in the boardroom of the Village of Pigeon.

Present: Robin Buschlen, Nancy Heck, John P. Kohr, David McCormick, John Walsh, Kelly Hanson Huron County Sheriff, Michael LePage, Eric Wissner and Steven Corrion from the Village of Pigeon, Matt Reibling, Supervisor-Elect and David Armbruster, Trustee-Elect.

The pledge of Allegiance was given.

The Oath of Office was administered, by John P. Kohr, Supervisor, to all recently elected township officials.

The minutes of the last regular meeting, held October 6, 2020, had been distributed to each board member. There being no corrections or additions, the minutes were approved.

Michael LePage, Village of Pigeon President and Eric Wissner, Pigeon Chief of Police, discussed the excellent relationship that the village and township have enjoyed over the past years. Eric Wissner discussed a proposed joint venture between the village and township to address the

blight issue in our jurisdictions and the patrol of township roads. They will present a potential agreement at the next township regular meeting.

Kelly Hanson, Huron County Sheriff, discussed the good relationship the sheriff's department has had with the township and then, presented John P. Kohr with a Certificate of Appreciation for his thirty four years [plus the Fire Department] of service to Winsor Township.

A motion was made by Nancy Heck, supported by Robin Buschlen, to approve the payment of the October bills and to authorize payment of the November bills of \$21,749.64. the motion carried.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Robin Buschlen, supported by David McCormick, to adjourn. The motion carried.
