

WINSOR TOWNSHIP
BOARD MEETING
JUNE 1, 2021

The regular meeting of the Winsor Township Board was called to order at 5:00 pm by Matt Reibling in the township boardroom.

Present: David Armbruster, Nancy Heck, David McCormick, Matt Reibling and John Walsh. Also Nick Pavlechek Fire Chief and Todd Talaski Huron County Commissioner.

Todd Talaski reviewed county activities and noted that the Covid related renovations have been completed at the Huron County Building.

The minutes of the last regular meeting, held on May 4, 2021, had been distributed to each board member. There being no additions or corrections, the minutes were approved, with the notation that the date of the approval of minutes [normally the next regular meeting], will be added to each set of minutes. A motion was made by David McCormick, supported by David Armbruster, to approve the minutes and notation. The motion carried.

A motion was made by David Armbruster, supported by Nancy Heck, to approve the May 2021 bills paid of \$10,237.31 and to authorize payment of the June 2021 bills of \$15,996.73. The motion carried.

statements could be e-mailed to board members before the meeting? John Walsh said that they will be, provided that the calendar cooperates, which it seldom does because of our early meeting date.


Nick Pavlechek, Fire Chief, reported on department activities noting that four members are taking "Fire Fighter 2" training.

An updated Winsor Township Cemetery Ordinance #2021-2 had been distributed to each board member for review. After discussion, noting areas in the cemetery needing improvement and suggesting that each new purchaser of a burial space should be given a copy of the Ordinance. A motion was made by David Armbruster, supported by Nancy Heck, to approve the Ordinance #2021-2, to be effective after publication. The motion carried.

Nancy Heck, Treasurer, reported that a new assessing bid should be available for the next meeting also that Detroit Edison will be trimming trees and shrubbery along the east, south and western sides of the cemetery.

Matt Reibling reported that the township has a SAM and a DUNS number which will be used to receive federal funds. He also noted that he will be attending a round-table discussion with Lisa McClain's office on June 2, 2021.

There being no further business, a motion was made by David McCormick, supported by David Armbruster, to adjourn. The motion carried.
